The G20 Leaders Summit (the Summit) will be held on 15 and 16 November 2014 at the Brisbane Convention Centre. The Summit will attract 26 world leaders, around 4,000 delegates and 3,000 media representatives to Brisbane and south east Queensland.

Impact

This event will have an impact on both traffic and transport into, out of and around Brisbane from 10 to 17 November. Please be prepared for changes to traffic arrangements including roads (closures and diversions) and to public transport.
