Canberra Fog Season 2019

Dear Entity Travel Manager,

As a result of Canberra's fog season, travellers may experience delays in arrivals and departures from Canberra Airport due to visibility issues.

In most cases, aircraft that are parked at the airport overnight for flights before 8.00am are able to depart in the morning. Qantas and Virgin Australia have advised that this applies to the following flights:

Qantas Airways:

Canberra → Sydney QF1510 / QF1464

Canberra → Adelaide QF713
Canberra → Melbourne QF795
Canberra → Brisbane QF1562

Virgin Australia:

Canberra → Sydney VA625 Canberra → Melbourne VA252

Canberra → Brisbane VA1207 (Monday only)
Canberra → Brisbane VA1209 (Tuesday – Friday)

Canberra → Adelaide VA625 (via Sydney)
Canberra → Adelaide VA252 (via Melbourne)

During the season, please advise your travellers to check the status of their flights with the relevant airline before heading to the airport. If business travel is critical or includes domestic and international connections, it may be worthwhile for travellers to fly out the night prior to avoid potential delays.

Travellers should also be aware that fog can affect Brisbane, Adelaide and Melbourne airports.
