Subject: Extension of the WoAG Car Rental Arrangement

Dear Entity Travel Manager,

This advice provides guidance to entities on the extension of the Whole of Australian Government Car Rental Arrangement (the Arrangement).

The Department of Finance has executed an additional two three-month extension options and both Deeds, Europcar and Thrifty, will now expire on 30 June 2018.

AusTender reporting

Individual entities are not required to publish their own Contract Notices on AusTender for car rental expenditure against the two service providers. Finance has, on behalf of the Commonwealth, previously published a Contract Notice (CN700821) estimating the total expenditure of the Commonwealth for the initial Deed period and extension periods against the Car Rental Services Standing Offer SON590091. Finance will amend this Contract Notice on behalf of the Commonwealth based on the data provided by the car rental companies.

Any related car rental purchase orders and payments must be blocked from reporting to AusTender from entity input systems (e.g. for SAP systems, the blocking code is 'Previously Gazetted').

What do entities need to do?

Entities do not need to do anything. The Notices of Accession for Car Rental services are linked to the respective Deeds.

The Deeds will be updated on Govdex shortly.
