CCS Clause	C.C.22 Compliance with Laws
Authority	To comply with any reporting requirements.
<p>Changes:</p> <p>C.C.22 Compliance with Commonwealth Laws and Policies:</p> <p>The Supplier must comply with, and ensure its officers, employees, agents and subcontractors comply with all Commonwealth laws and policies relevant to the Goods and/or Services <u>and must provide such reports and other information regarding compliance as reasonably requested by the Customer or as otherwise required by a relevant law or policy.</u></p> <p>If the Supplier becomes aware of any actual or suspected breach of the requirements set out in clauses A to G below, it must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) immediately report it to the Customer and provide a written report on the matter within five (5) business days; and (b) <u>comply</u> with any reasonable directions by the Customer in relation to any investigation or further reporting of the actual or suspected breach.
