Exciting developments have taken place over the last month after reaching a key milestone with commencement of the John Gorton Campus (JGC) Car Park.

JGC Car Park – Update

Closure of the on-grade John Gorton East Car Park and Dorothy Tangney Place commenced as scheduled on **17 July 2023** for construction of the new car park. Finance extends thanks for the constructive engagement with entities over recent months, resulting in a smooth process for the car park closure and transition for users.

Site investigation works and minor demolition activities have commenced, site establishment works continue including shade cloth to fencing and installation of site accommodation and amenities. The Head Contractor, Barpa is continuing finalisation of design and progression of the National Capital Works approvals.

Smoking Ceremony

Finance held a smoking ceremony and sod turning event on Tuesday, 8 August 2023 at the JCG Car Park site to celebrate the commencement of the Project. The Finance Project Team and Barpa were joined by the Minister for Finance, Senator the Hon Katy Gallagher, Ms Alicia Payne MP, Member for Canberra, Ngunnawal Elder, Aunty Violet Sheridan, Barpa Chairperson and Dja Dja Wurrung Elder, Graham Atkinson, and Finance Secretary, Jenny Wilkinson to mark the occasion.

Aunty Violet Sheridan led the Welcome to County and smoking ceremony with the Minister for Finance delivering the opening speech, the Minister noted:

"This is just the first step in a major project for Canberra, the National Security Office Precinct, which will create thousands of jobs over the life of the project."

Barpa, a proud Indigenous owned company, is delivering the project valued at \$80.8 million, which is the largest contract awarded by Finance to an Indigenous owned

business. It is also the first major construction to take place in the Parliamentary Triangle since completion of the National Portrait Gallery in 2008 and is expected to create over 180 jobs.

The commencement of the JGC Car Park is a critical enabling project for the development of the National Security Office Precinct Project.

Bus Stop Relocation

The relocation of the Kings Avenue bus stop 3028 is expected to occur in October 2023. The bus stop will move 150m up the road, in line with the existing bus stop on the other side of Kings Avenue. It is anticipated it will take around one week to move the shelter.

Preliminary Works to commence in September 2023, with Main Works expected to commence in October 2023 until February 2024. Finance will work closely with affected entities on upcoming changes. Tree Removal

Tree removal works commenced at the JGC Car Park in late July 2023, with some significant trees being retained in accordance with the environmental referral, for repurposing that may form part of the landscape design - options for repurposing are currently under consideration.

York Park Site - Investigations

Lendlease is continuing to undertake preliminary Geothermal site investigation works at the York Park Car Park, which are expected to be completed over the next fortnight.

The Car Park remains open, with minimal disruption to car park users.
