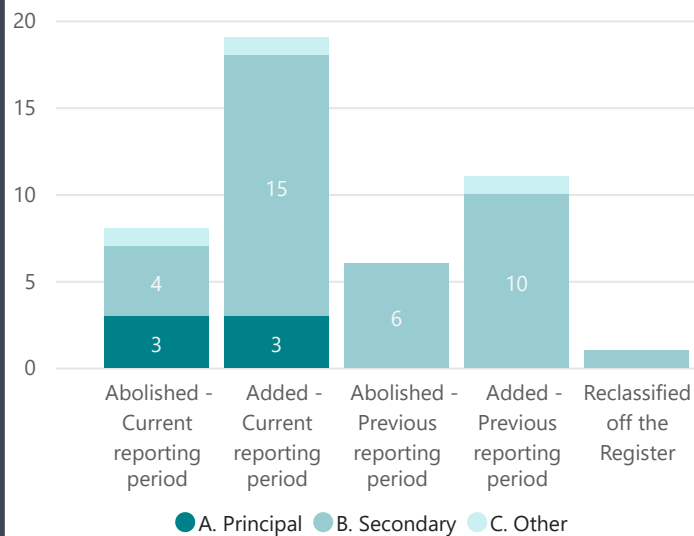
The Australian Government Organisations Register (AGOR) provides information on the function, composition, origins and other details of Australian Government bodies.

The dataset is updated continuously and the following statistics reflect the dataset as at **30 September 2023**. The statistics are updated on a quarterly basis.

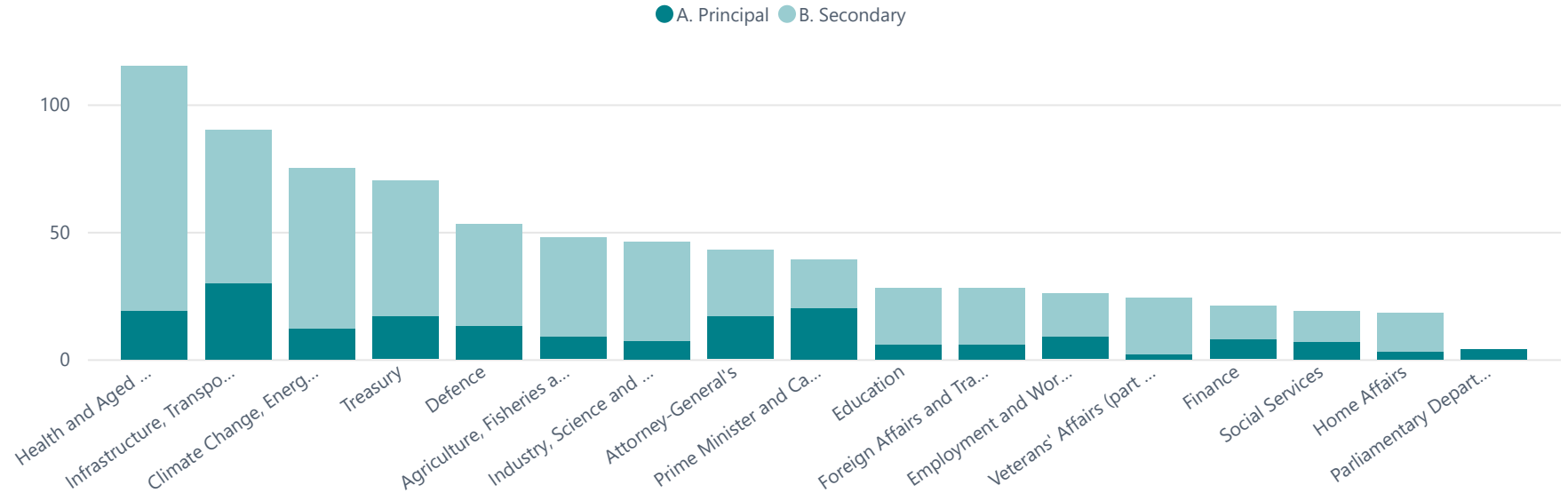
Summary of Movements 30 June 2023 - 30 September 2023

The total number of Primary bodies, Secondary bodies and Other governance relationships reported on AGOR as at **30 September 2023** is **1,327**.

14 bodies that were ceased by the Government have been removed, 30 bodies added and 1 body reclassified on AGOR since the last update as at 30 June 2023.
