- are more than 8km from a polling place
- are travelling
- can't leave your workplace to vote
- are seriously ill, infirm or due to give birth shortly (or if you are caring for someone who is)

- are in prison serving a sentence of less than three years or otherwise detained polling place
 - are a silent elector
