CHRIS KENNY:

I need to cut that off because related to that I just want to show you a debate that has broken out on Twitter today, an attack. Let's first have a look at a tweet here from the Channel Ten journalist Paul Bongiorno. He's now with some other leftist organisation I think. But he says I notice the Finance Minister Mathias Cormann is into assertion. He asserts against evidence of the independent auditor after ten months of investigating that everyone was eligible. It's a technique invented by Goebbels, the big lie. So here we go the Nazi slur, thrown at Mathias Cormann of all people, of course of Belgian origin with that strong Germanic accent. Let's see what Mathias Cormann has responded publicly, are you for real! I speak with a German accent, so you accuse me of being a Nazi? You are absolutely despicable Paul Bongiorno. You clearly do not know what you are talking about. This is a disgrace and you should apologise. Your view on that Eric Abetz.
