### **Talking Points**

### Reactions to Iran's strikes on US Bases in Iraq and Qatar

- Australia condemns the attack on US air bases
- There are no reports of Australian casualties
- We again call for de-escalation, dialogue and diplomacy.

### Are Australian Defence Force members posted in the region safe?

- The Australian Defence Force continually revises force protection measures for its personnel deployed across the Middle East region.
- For operational security reasons, Defence does not comment on the nature of force protection measures.

#### What does this mean for Australians wanting to depart the region?

• The situation on the ground is rapidly changing.

- Subject to conditions on the ground, and airspace being open, we are continuing to plan for assisted departures from Israel by land and air
  - and are communicating these plans directly to Australians who wish to depart.
  - Plans may change at short notice.
- When we have those opportunities, we plan to take them.
- We urge Australians who want to leave Iran to do so now, if it is safe.
  - Those who are unable to or do not wish to leave, are advised to shelter in place.
  - If you can get to Azerbaijan, DFAT has consular staff at the border ready to support you.

#### Reactions to US strikes on Iran's nuclear sites

- The US action was directed at specific sites central to Iran's nuclear program
  we continue to call for de-escalation, dialogue and diplomacy.
- We have been clear that Iran's nuclear program is a threat to global peace and security, and the security of the region.
- The security situation in the region *remains* highly volatile.

**If pressed on US action:** We support action to prevent Iran from being allowed to get a nuclear weapon.




