Prior round Decisions Taken But Not Yet Announced (DTBNYAs) announced since the 2025-26 Budget and published in the 2025 PEFO.

Key facts and figures

- Five DTBNYAs were announced between the 2025-26 Budget and the 2025 Pre-election Economic and Fiscal Outlook (PEFO).
 - Details of the announced DTBNYAs were published in the 2025 PEFO and are available in *Appendix B: Policy decisions since the 2025-26 Budget (Page 23-28)*.
 - The financial impacts of these decisions are shown as dashes in the 2025 PEFO as they have already been reflected in the budget estimates in earlier rounds.
- Consistent with the *Charter of Budget Honesty Act 1998*, all decisions that were made or in existence before the issue of the writ for the 2025 Federal Election on 31 March 2025 were disclosed in the 2025 PEFO.
 - As all DTBNYAs were announced in PEFO, there have been no further announcements.
